Web Seminars

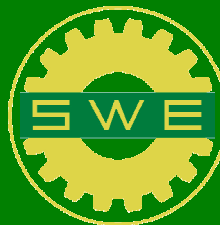

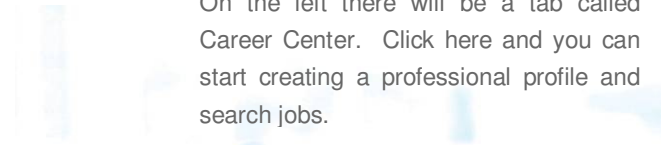
